“Feedback Informed Treatment (FIT); Improving the Quality and Outcome of Behavioral Health Services, Including Hypnosis, One Person at a Time.”

A **new era** is coming in the evaluation of effectiveness of diagnosis and treatment in medicine and in mental health. Patients, clients, insurance, and government agencies are starting to look and pay not only for the process of therapeutic intervention but more and more for the clinical outcome. The precision of assessment is increasing almost by the hour as more and more data have become available in digital form and, literally, at the tip of one’s fingers. Word of mouth and simple advertisements are now joined by readily available data on the quality of care provided by each individual practitioner. While practitioners in the medical field are already seeing their practices affected by the quality of the clinical outcomes, mental health practitioners will not be shielded from the scrutiny of how good the results of their interventions are.

Practitioners of clinical hypnosis need to be prepared that just doing hypnosis, like any other type of therapy or treatment, is not enough anymore. We need to learn how to better assess our results, prepare for positive and negative feedback and use it to get better. We also need to teach our students to fearlessly inquire as to what works and what does not to prepare them for the new realities of practice.
