Maui is truly in a full disaster: A Message from Maui By ASCH Past Past President Bridget Bongaard



Maui is truly in a full disaster. Walls of flames 30 feet high went by our house in Kula on Tuesday evening, August 8, whipped by Hurricane Dora's 40 to 80 mph winds. If the direction of the winds had changed that night, I would not be writing this now. We could also see the fires downhill advancing to Kihei. We did not know about the fires that started in Lahaina...

We took in evacuees and pets then in the morning began relief efforts. Food to fire squads, purchasing essential goods and taking to shelters. Setting up a donation tab on our nonprofit website, <u>Maui Cancer Resources</u>. Boots on ground got items there despite closed roads to Lahaina by marshalling our local tour boats who served selflessly.

We are now working to establish grief/trauma services to help those who have experienced loss of houses burned in front of their eyes, those who ran from the fire and who got separated from their loved ones, whose shoes melted when they jumped from their cars ahead of the wall of flames, those who made it to the ocean and jumped into the sea dodged flaming embers for five hours before rescue as the town was incinerated before their eyes, punctuated by the sounds of a multitude of nearby parked cars in the tourist town blowing up like bombs. The agonizing search for loved ones and pets. There is more with the horrors of toxic waste, looters, loss of livelihoods, heritage. Ambulance sirens scream down the few roads daily adding to the continued hypervigilance of those who survived.

I am grateful to ASCH for all my years of training and so help to begin the healing by doing grief and trauma work in addition to keeping track of all our cancer patients and their needs.

If anyone would like to support this work, they may make donations through Maui Cancer Resources website.

I thank my ASCH colleagues for those who reached out since this began with their support. We are a nonprofit of non-salaried professionals so all goes straight back to supplies or pro bono patient consultations/treatment. If you wish to send support with a donation, you will also receive a letter with for taxes purposes with our EIN number.

Dr. Charlene Bell, an ASCH member from Oahu, is joining me in this work as well. Here is ASCH training put towards one of the greatest good and exemplifies the importance, relevance of our education, and steadfast dedication to relieve human suffering.

Advanced Teaching and Consultation Workshops Promote Greater Understanding, New Approaches

ASCH is offering a virtual Teaching and Consultation Workshop and an in-person advanced workshop in October. We also have spots left in our in person <u>Albuquerque offerings in</u> September!

Teaching and Consultation Workshop

October 6-7, 2023

The Teaching & Consultation Workshop (TCW) is a 10-hour virtual workshop designed for those individuals who have attained ASCH Certification and are seeking Approved Consultant status. The TCW includes an introduction that addresses professional continuing education standards, workshop learning objectives, and fostering of positive working relationships among participants and workshop faculty.

Registration is now open.

ASCH Level 2 & Advanced Workshops

October 19-22, 2023

The second step in certification training is to strengthen skills, strategies and applications of clinical hypnosis. Part one taught "how to" do clinical hypnosis, and part two builds on this skill set and refines and furthers development to add the when, why and where to the "how to".

This workshop expands the participants' skill sets and builds greater confidence in the use of hypnosis. It prepares the participant to move on to Advanced (Skills) Workshops and Individual Consultation to build a greater understanding of principles and advance one's skill level.

Certification through ASCH must be renewed every three years. In order to renew your ASCH Certification, you must have completed at least 20 hours of ASCH-approved hypnosis training within the last three years. Additional requirements below:

Certification

- Hold at least a master's degree in a health care discipline considered appropriate by the Society and have licensure/certification in the state/ province which they practice;
- Membership in a professional society consistent with a degree;
- Licensure or certification by the state or province in which they practice to practice independently;
- Complete Level 1 and Level 2 ASCH approved Clinical Workshop training;
- Minimum of 20 hours of individualized training/consultation with an ASCH Approved Consultant;
- Minimum of two years of independent practice utilizing clinical hypnosis (two years from the completion of the basic course).

Approved Consultant

All of the requirements for Certification in Clinical Hypnosis, plus:

- Minimum of 40 additional hours of ASCH approved Advanced workshop training;
- Completion of the 10-hour Teaching and Consultation Workshop (TCW)
- Minimum of five years of independent practice utilizing clinical hypnosis (5 years from the completion of the basic program);
- Minimum of five years of membership in ASCH, SCEH or equivalent.
